COMPETITION BRIEF

The **Graduation Projects Competition 4.0, MENA Region Edition** is a competition dedicated to recognizing outstanding academic graduation projects from across **North Africa, the Levant, and the Gulf**. The initiative creates a platform for emerging designers to present the ambition, research, and design thinking developed through their final academic projects.

The competition invites **2025–2026 graduates** in architecture, interior architecture, urban design, landscape, and related spatial design fields to submit their academic graduation projects for regional review. Each submission represents an individual design vision, while also reflecting a wider cultural, environmental, social, and urban context.

Through a structured selection process, projects progress from **national recognition** to **regional evaluation**. This approach ensures that entries are first reviewed within their local context before being positioned within a broader regional conversation. Submissions will be assessed based on the strength of the design narrative, the originality and innovation of the project, the quality of its spatial, technical, and environmental resolution, and the clarity and effectiveness of its representation and communication.

Beyond recognition, the competition aims to bridge the gap between academic work and professional practice. By connecting students and graduates with jurors, academics, professional firms, media platforms, and industry leaders, WeAreDESCO supports the **transition from university studios to wider architectural discourse** and future practice.

Leading global architecture and design practices are looking for the next generation of talent. Through The **Graduation Projects Competition 4.0**, selected participants will gain visibility across DESC0's professional network, with the **Grand Winner** receiving an internship opportunity with **one of the world's leading architecture offices**.

Beyond the Grand Winner, the competition aims to connect promising graduates with architecture and design firms in their own countries and across the wider region. Selected participants may gain access to mentorship, portfolio review, digital publication, jury engagement, and further professional opportunities with partner firms.

These opportunities are designed to **support emerging designers** as they move **from academic achievement** toward **professional development**, turning **graduation projects into a bridge between the university studio and future practice**.

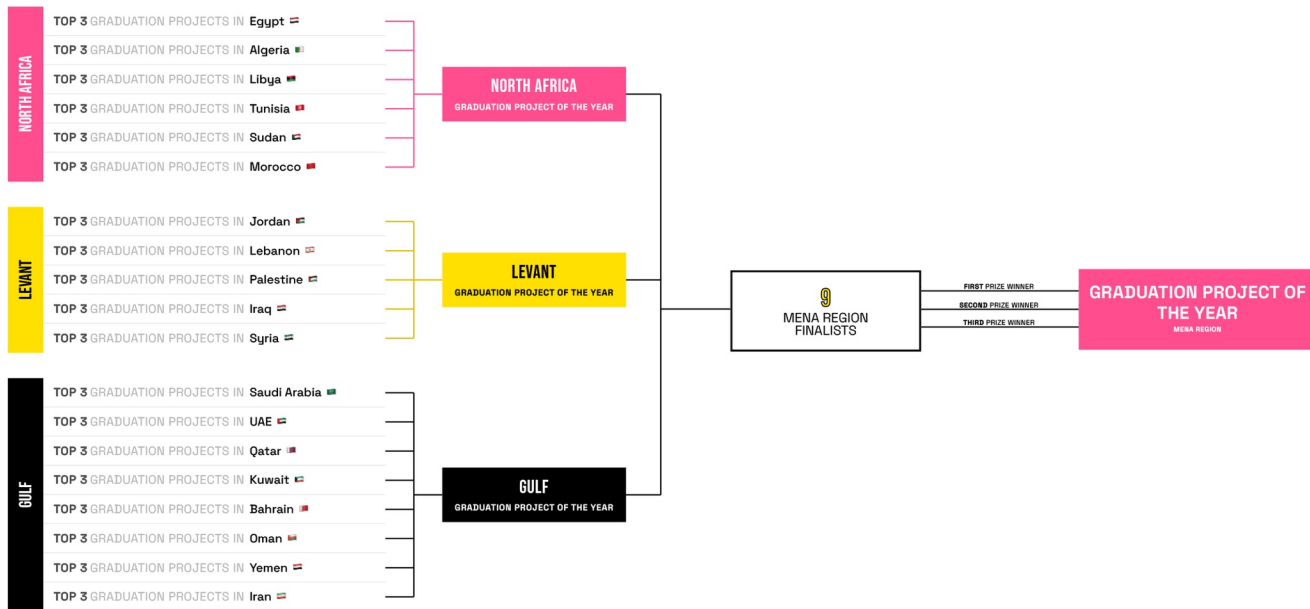

Participants are required to submit one PDF file containing a **maximum of 10 project sheets**. The submission should clearly communicate the project's concept, context, design process, architectural drawings, spatial resolution, and final proposal. The proposal should follow the sheet structure outlined:

HOW TO SUBMIT.

01. REGISTER ONLINE

02. RECEIVE YOUR ORDER NUMBER

After registration, you will receive a confirmation email with your order number.

03. USE YOUR ORDER NUMBER AS YOUR REGISTRATION CODE

04. DOWNLOAD THE SUBMISSION TEMPLATE

05. PREPARE YOUR SUBMISSION

Add your registration code to the template and place all project sheets into one PDF file.

06. NAME YOUR FILE CORRECTLY

Use your registration code in the file name before uploading your PDF.

07. UPLOAD YOUR FINAL PDF

Complete the submission form on the website and upload your final PDF before the submission deadline.

COMPETITION REGULATIONS.

01 / ANONYMOUS SUBMISSION

All submissions must remain anonymous. The order number issued after registration will serve as the participant's registration code and must be used as the only form of identification on all submission materials.

02 / LANGUAGE & FORMAT

All submitted materials must be in English and must follow the official DESCO submission template, file format, page limit, and naming requirements stated in this brief.

03 / REGISTRATION & FEES

Registration must be completed through the official WeAreDESCO website before the submission deadline. Registration fees are charged per submitted project and are non-refundable once payment is completed.

04 / ORIGINALITY & AUTHORSHIP

Submitted work must be the participant's own original academic work. Plagiarism, false information, misrepresentation of authorship, or the submission of work that does not belong to the applicant may result in disqualification.

05 / JURY COMMUNICATION

Participants must not contact jury members regarding their submissions at any stage of the competition. Any attempt to influence the jury process may result in disqualification.

06 / EVALUATION & DISQUALIFICATION

Submissions will be reviewed according to the published evaluation criteria. Late, incomplete, incorrectly formatted, non-anonymous, or non-compliant submissions may be excluded from evaluation.

07 / PUBLICATION RIGHTS

Participants retain ownership of their work. By entering the competition, participants grant WeAreDESCO the right to publish, feature, share, exhibit, and promote submitted materials for competition-related, educational, media, and promotional purposes.

08 / PROFESSIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

WeAreDESCO may facilitate connections between selected participants and partner firms, mentors, jurors, media platforms, or industry professionals. Internship and professional opportunities are subject to partner-firm selection criteria, eligibility requirements, availability, visa conditions, and final onboarding processes.

09 / PARTNER-FIRM SELECTION

Partner firms may independently review visible projects and consider participants for internships or professional opportunities based on their own hiring criteria, portfolio needs, and internal requirements. Selection by a partner firm is not solely determined by competition ranking.

10 / TIMELINE & UPDATES

ELIGIBILITY.

01. WHO CAN ENTER

The competition is open to final-year students and recent graduates from eligible countries across North Africa, the Levant & Mesopotamia, and the Arabian Peninsula.

02. ELIGIBLE DISCIPLINES

Applicants may submit graduation projects from architecture, interior architecture, urban design, landscape, and related spatial design fields.

03. PROJECT TYPE

Each submission must be an original academic graduation project completed as part of a recognized university programme.

04. ACADEMIC YEAR

Eligible projects must be completed or submitted during the 2025–2026 academic year.

05. INDIVIDUALS & TEAMS

Projects may be submitted individually or by teams. All team members must be listed during registration, and one main contact person must be assigned for communication

06. COUNTRY ELIGIBILITY

Applicants are eligible to enter if they meet at least one of the following conditions: they are citizens of one of the eligible countries, residents of one of the eligible countries, or enrolled in / recently graduated from a university located in one of the eligible countries listed in this brief.

07. ONE PROJECT PER ENTRY

Each registration allows the submission of one graduation project only, and applicants who wish to submit more than one project must complete a separate registration for each entry.

08. NOT ELIGIBLE

Jury members, DESCO organizers, competition administrators, and applicants with a direct conflict of interest are not eligible to participate. All submitted projects must be the applicant's own original academic work.
